ABOUT US



We began as a dance program at the YMCA. Laura Hanson and Amanda Wike opened the studio for summer dance camps in June 2020 and Statesville Dance was born!



Statesville Dance welcomed Ms. Ally Capehart as an instructor in 2021. The studio continues to grow and recently expanded to add another 2,400 sq foot studio.



We take pride in being a part of our local community and perform at many events such as Pumpkin Festival, Balloon Festival and the Statesville Christmas Parade.



We also host Birthday parties and special events such as Parents Night Out and a Car Show.

We strive to have excellent communication with our dance families and build a friendly, positive environment in and around the dance studio.

Class Placement

Through years of training and teaching, we have learned that class placement has many facets. As a result, our studio faculty meets regularly to discuss students' progress and/or placement. It is our policy to offer appropriate opportunities to every child.

We consider placing a child in a particular group or class where he or she will feel confident, in order to promote the development of self-esteem. Some students who are placed in higher levels become discouraged, only to lose their passion for dance. Others respond to the challenge of being in a class with students who are more proficient by pushing themselves to work harder. Placement is highly individual and the factors that go into the decision are complex. We want our students to succeed in dance and life!

RISING STARS PROGRAM -- All classes perform in year end recital.

Twinkle Toes (Ages 2.5-3)

Designed for our very young dancers, our Creative Movement Dance class is a great introduction into movement and music. For many students, this is the first time being away from Mom and Dad and this 30 minute class is a great way to start. Dancers explore stretches, sound, rhythms and locomotor movement as well as other life skills such as listening, taking turns and following directions.









RISING STARS PROGRAM -- All classes perform in year end recital.

Rising Stars 3, 4 & 5

Combining Ballet, Jazz, Tap and Creative Movement, this one-hour class develops your child's coordination as well as helps them gain an understanding of basic dance concepts and terminology. This broad introduction into dance creates much excitement and prepares them for many future dance genres.

Mini Hip Hop (Ages 5-6)

This high-energy hip-hop class incorporates a variety of old and new urban dance styles. The dancing represents body movements that go with the beat and rhythm of hip-hop music. Hip hop dancing is very dynamic and helps dancers improve their flexibility, develop body balance, and coordination.

Preschool Acrobatic Arts (Ages 4-7)

The AcroDance Preschool Program is designed to introduce physical literacy, coordination, creative movement and basic acrobatic skills to students aged three to five years. This program includes lesson plans, music, and teaching props to take this early childhood dance program to a new level!

Ballet

Ballet dance is the foundation of all dance and its techniques are needed to be proficient in all other styles of dance. Ballet classes help with posture, balance, flexibility, self-discipline and self-confidence.

Jazz

Jazz classes include a warm-up, center floor technique, progressions and combination work with a focus on learning not just the steps and skills, but also the associated terminology. Jazz classes include a focus on body alignment, conditioning, flexibility, rhythm, musicality and style.

Tap

Tap utilizes rhythm, syncopation, and sound in addition to movement. An emphasis is placed on musicality, expression, and improvisation. Tap is offered in three levels; class placement is determined by skill level and students often repeat levels until they have achieved mastery.

Hip Hop

Hip Hop is a high energy class that includes street dancing, breaking, popping and locking. Class encourages students to step outside the box by bringing their own individual style and personality to the movements.

Lyrical

Lyrical is the fusion of different dance styles (Ballet, Modern, Jazz etc.) stressing versatility and expression. This class focusses on self-expression, special awareness and body movement.

Musical Theater (Ages 8 & Up)

Students learn choreography from selected Broadway musicals. With a little bit of group singing, some drama and a lot of dance we will experiment with a variety of dance styles along with acting and developing character. It's the kind of drama parents have no issues with developing!











ACROBATIC ARTS ® -- All classes perform in year end recital.

Acrobatic Dance, or acro as it is commonly referred to by dancers and dance professionals, is the beautiful fusion of classic dance technique and the precision and athleticism of acrobatic elements. Often defined by unique choreography, acro dancers seamlessly blend musicality, emotional expression, line and extension with acrobatic movements in a dance context.

Acrobatic Arts starts at the very beginning, teaching students what they need to know about proper placement and technique so they will have the building blocks to progress safely and quickly from one level to the next. Acrobatic Arts is a foundational program for Acro Dance taught over 12 levels in progression: with each level building on the pervious level's requirements. Theory classes including anatomy and choreography as well as practical classes in spotting ensure that Acrobatic Arts Certified Teachers understand how to properly introduce skills with excellent technique in a safe and fun environment. The material taught is based in true acro, preparing students to perform skills on a hard stage as part of a complete dance routine package, in 5 skill areas: Flexibility, Strength, Limbering, Balancing and Tumbling.

The syllabus contains 12 levels with well thought out progressions that take students and teachers from the very beginning to advanced levels. We love how well rounded and progressive this program is and are looking forward to watching our students grow even more in their dance education.

Join us for Acro Dance (Ages 6 and up) or Acro Dance Preschool (Ages 3-5). All placement levels are determined by instructors.

PRESCHOOL PARENTS

Our purpose is to provide the highest-quality preschool education in a secure, nurturing, and stimulating environment. Statesville Dance serves the physical, emotional, and intellectual needs of the preschool students. We meet these goals with our age-appropriate curriculum and ongoing communication with parents.

The first few weeks of classes serve as an introductory phase to help students become comfortable with the overall dance experience, the classroom, their teacher, and their classmates. From the beginning, we focus on your child's coordination, listening skills, musical awareness, and developing imagination. We accomplish this through age-appropriate music and song, simple stretching exercises, dance basics, and games in an environment of creativity. Preschool dance is about helping children learn to tap into their imaginations and express themselves creatively, not necessarily about learning steps (although they will be introduced to basic technique). Just because your child doesn't pirouette around the house or look like a budding ballerina right away doesn't mean important skills are not being learned.

Separation from the Parent

The process of separating from the parent as the child attends dance class is an important accomplishment of preschool children. As children mature, they begin to identify themselves as independent personalities. In separating from you, your child is learning important life skills such as:

- developing interest in the activities of the dance class
- feeling comfortable with other children in the class
- understanding that his/her parent will come back and pick him/her up as well as all parents return to pick up their kids

PRESCHOOL PARENTS

It is important to know that many young children explore the limits of attending dance class and say they don't want to go. This may occur anytime, but it is usually short-lived. Here are some suggestions that may help you handle the situation:

- Emphasize what the child is doing at the dance class rather than what you do while he or she is in class.
- Avoid prolonged good-byes.
- Ask the teacher or assistant for help in separation. We expect the crying and we will patiently work your dancer through her/his difficult moments.
 Tears are usually short lived and quickly turn to a smiling face.

<u>Timing is Everything -- It May Not Be the Right Time</u>

If your child cries or does not want to take class, don't panic. If we push children and create more stress than they are already experiencing, they may perceive dance class as a bad experience. That kind of negativity could make them apprehensive about dance for a long time, which isn't good for anyone involved. Never force your child into the classroom. If your child stops attending class within the first month, the registration fee will be credited to the following year. We encourage you to have your child try again next year. We recommend that children be encouraged to practice at home but don't force them to do so. Repetition is one of the key elements for success with preschool dance students; the more they practice, the more confident they will feel. Practicing with your child allows you to join in the dance experience.

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TUITION FEE STRUCTURE

Tuition for recreational lessons at Statesville Dance is an annual fee, which is divided up into monthly installments. This fee is determined by the number of hours a student takes per week. Tuition is based on number of lessons for the month of August through May. Most months have four lessons, some months have three and other months, five. Tuition always remains the same for each month. If a student has absences, the tuition rate remains the same.

Once your payment is set up, before classes begin, there's nothing to do each month. Statesville Dance will automatically debit your checking /savings account or debit/credit card on file the 15th of each month. The first month is due at registration which covers August and payment on August 15th will cover September. This continues monthly on the 15th with the last payment on April 15th.

TUITION FEE STRUCTURE

Annual Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of \$35 per dancer is due at registration to hold your dancers place. For families, the fee is \$35 for the first student and \$15 for each additional student. This fee is non-refundable and paid annually.

Competition Teams Only: You will be notified of Tuition & Fees through acceptance packages after Competition Team Auditions.

Monthly Tuition

Students first month's tuition is also due at registration. Tuition is billed automatically on the 15th of each month. A \$25 late payment fee will be charged if payment is returned or late.

General Dress Code:

Hair: Girl's hair should be pulled off the face for all classes. For Ballet classes hair should be in a bun.

Jewelry: All jewelry including necklaces, bracelets, smart watches, rings, and angel bracelets should be removed before entering the studio. Stud earrings are allowed.

Personal belongings: Please label ALL personal belongings, especially dance shoes (on the inside, not visible) with first and last name.

All shoes and dance uniforms are available to purchase at the Statesville Dance Store.

Black Ballet Dress, pink/flesh ballet tights, pink/flesh ballet shoes.

Classic Tank Teal Leotard, pink/flesh ballet tights and pink/flesh ballet shoes.

Boys- solid white t-shirt, black tights or shorts or sweatpants, and black ballet shoes.

Ballet IV

Classic Tank Navy Leotard, pink/flesh tights and pink/flesh ballet shoes.

Ballet V

Black Leotard of chocie, pink/flesh tights and pink/flesh ballet shoes.

Lyrical

Black leotard, black leggings, footless tights or jazz pants and Foot Undies Boys- Comfortable dance attire, no shoes.

Hip Hop

Comfortable athletic wear. Designate a pair of sneakers to wear only for dance class that are clean and free of dirt and debris. This helps protect our studio floors. You may change into these inside the studio. No boots, sandals, flip-flop, crocs or jeans.

Tap

Girls- Black leggings, any Statesville Dance shirt or tank top, tan tap shoes.

Boys- Statesville Dance t-shirt and black pants and black tap shoes.

Jazz and Musical Theater

Girls - Black dance wear, leotard and leggings or tank top and leggings -- tan jazz shoes.

Dress Code Boys: Black sweatpants, Black t-shirt and black jazz shoes

Acrobatic Arts

Level I - Grape Biketard Level II - Teal Biketard

Boys- solid black t-shirt, black sweatpants











RECITAL FEES

Costume Fees (Competition Teams, see note regarding fees on page 16)

All students participating in the end of year Dance recital will need to purchase a costume for each class that they participate. Costume fees are due no later than **OCTOBER 2nd 2024**. **All costume fees are non-refundable**. Costumes will not be ordered without payment. If a child decides to forgo participating in dance, there are NO REFUNDS, NO RETURNS, NO EXCEPTIONS, NON-NEGOTIABLE. Statesville Dance will hand out costumes once they are ready, during class time. Costume fees and accounts must be up to date before costume is given to a student.

- ALL COSTUMES \$85 per class
- \$35 fee for Shoes for all Hip Hop Classes. Hip Hop Boys will be required to purchase their own black sneakers for recital.

All classes are required to purchase the correct dance shoes through Statesville Dance store.

Recital Fees

On March 15th 2025 a Dance Recital Fee will be automatically drafted from your account. This covers the cost of the auditorium, trophy and recital t-shirt. This fee is non-refundable and non-negotiable. \$45 per student.















TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Tuition fees are drafted on the 15th of every month for the following month. For example, September 15th will cover for October tuition. Last draft is April 15th.
- Fees paid late will incur late payment charge of \$25
- Accounts that are in arrears past the 1st of each month, will unfortunately result in Dance being withheld until the account is brought up to date. If fees remain unpaid then the student will be considered unenrolled.
- Students wishing to discontinue a class must give 3-weeks notice IN WRITING to the Studio Owner via email to info@statesvilledance.com. A 3-week's written notice is required from the parent/guardian and is required to not be charged the next full month's tuition. Any remaining balance will be settled at the time of withdrawal. The card on file will be charged for the remaining balance.
- Tuition and registration fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. Notification to withdraw from a class must be received in writing. Cancellation is not confirmed until you receive an email or call back from us. If student is dismissed from the studio for any reason, tuition is non-refundable.
- Incase of inclement weather, Statesville Dance will generally follow the decision of the Iredell Statesville Schools system. There will be information regarding inclement weather via Facebook, Instagram and Email. No refunds for cancelled classes.
- Students are expected to commit fully to all classes. Statesville Dance has an
 extremely packed calendar and repeated absences from lessons is not accepted.
 Choreography is adversely impacted by absences. Therefore, other students are
 negatively impacted by other's absences.
- Students who are unable to attend class due to sickness or other legitimate reasons should email Statesville Dancel as soon as possible. Please leave your child home with fever, viruses, and such. There are no refunds for missed classes. Makeup classes can be offered when available.
- If a student misses 4 classes in a row without contacting Statesville Dance, they will be removed from the register and should they wish to return, will have to re-join the waiting list.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Statesville Dance does not carry or provide any medical insurance for its dancers.
 Dancers must be covered by their family medical insurance. Statesville Dance is
 not responsible for any injuries that have or may occur due to participation. If
 injuries occur, it is understood that the dancer's family insurance is the only form
 of coverage.
- Students must wear the correct uniform and required hair style to classes at ALL times.
- Students are expected to work to their full potential at all times during class.
- Statesville Dance is committed to providing a safe, caring and respectful
 environment for all students and strictly enforces a prohibition against bullying,
 including cyber bullying. Bullying can take many forms and can occur in any
 setting. Bullying can include, but is not limited to, name calling or threatening,
 social alienation, spreading rumors and physical aggression. Any student
 demonstrating any types of bullying behavior will be immediately dismissed from
 Statesville Dance without refund.
- No chewing gum is allowed in class.
- No food or drink, except water, is allowed in the studio.
- We understand that some students will carry cell phones to class. Please ensure they turn their phone onto silent during class times and keep them safe in their bags. Statesville Dance is not responsible for any lost items.
- Statesville Dance cannot accept responsibility for any valuables brought on to the premises.
- Our Staff and Teachers have the right to be treated with respect at all times and we reserve the right to ask any student or parent to leave the premises if they are abusive either verbally or physically either towards staff, students or parents.
- Statesville Dance reserves the right to dismiss any student from our programs for any negative behavior inappropriate or unbecoming of a Statesville Dance representative.
- Parents agree to give our studio a valid email address and read these emails for information.
